## Getting Started:

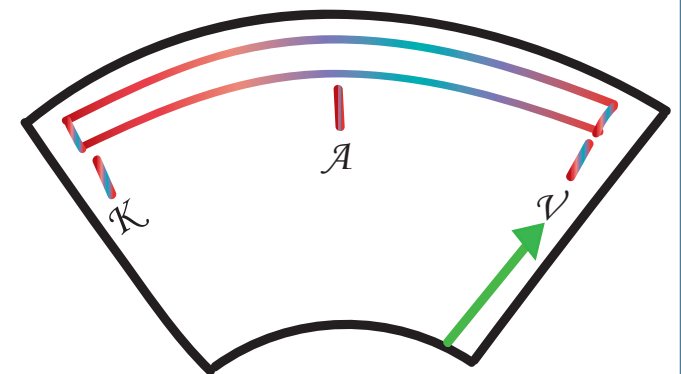
Use as a visual resource to learn about the virtues of memorising the Qur'an. It is very important to know the rewards of memorising as these should be major motivating factors for children.

# Virtues of Memorising the Qur'an

## Special People of Allah

"Allah has special groups from amongst the people. He was asked, 'Who are they, O Messenger of Allah?' He said, 'They are the people of the Qur'an; they are the special people of Allah.'" [Ahmad]

## Honourable

"Indeed from honouring Allah is to respect the elderly Muslim, the one who bears the Qur'an and the just ruler."  
[Sahih al-Targhib wal-Tarhib]

## With the angels

"The reward of the one who reads the Qur'an, having memorised it is with the most noble of angels..." [Bukhari]

## Read & rise

"It will be said to the one who bears the Qur'an on the Day of Judgement, 'Read, rise and recite as you used to recite in the world, for your final station is with the final verse you recite.'" [Abu Dawud]

## Honourable

"The Qur'an will come on the Day of Judgement and say, 'O my Lord, crown him.' So he will wear a crown of honour. It will then say, 'O my Lord, adorn him.' So he will wear adornments of honour. It will then say, 'O my Lord, be pleased with him.' So Allah will be pleased with him. It will then be said to him, 'Read, rise and for every verse you will have a reward.'" [Tirmidhi]

## With the angels

"The Qur'an will come on the Day of Judgement in the form of a different man. It will say, 'Do you know me?' I am the reason you would stay awake at night and fast the day. Every trader will walk behind his trade this day and I am yours today.' He will then be given kingdom to his right, eternity to his left and a crown of honour will be placed on his head. His parents will be given adornments worth more than the world and all within it. They will ask, 'O Lord, where has this come from?' The reply will be, 'For teaching your child the Qur'an.'"
